

Bumech's WSE debut

Bumech, a company specializing in servicing, maintaining and renovating heavy machinery equipment used in the mining industry, debuted on the main floor of the Warsaw Stock Exchange last Wednesday. The initial price per share was zł.13.6, but this jumped up to zł.21 at the start of trading and finished the day at zł.18.89. The company earned zł.5.5 million from the IPO. It was this year's second debut on the WSE, which lists 376 companies.
